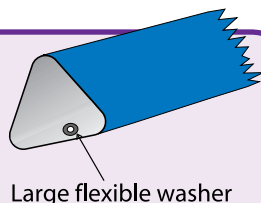

EASY INSTALLATION

- Drill holes in each end at least 1" in from the end.
- Drill corresponding hole in the dock frame
- Bolt Rhino Dock Fender to the dock frame. Use a large flexible washer.
- Use one Rhino Dock Fender per section or stack two Rhino Tubes for extra protection."
